This table only includes taxes paid to Australian Federal and State authorities. It does not include taxes paid or collected by CSL Australia in foreign jurisdictions. In 2019, CSL Australia paid A\$18.8m in withholding taxes to overseas governments. In accordance with the Australian tax law, this withholding tax is available for offset against the Australian income tax liability.
